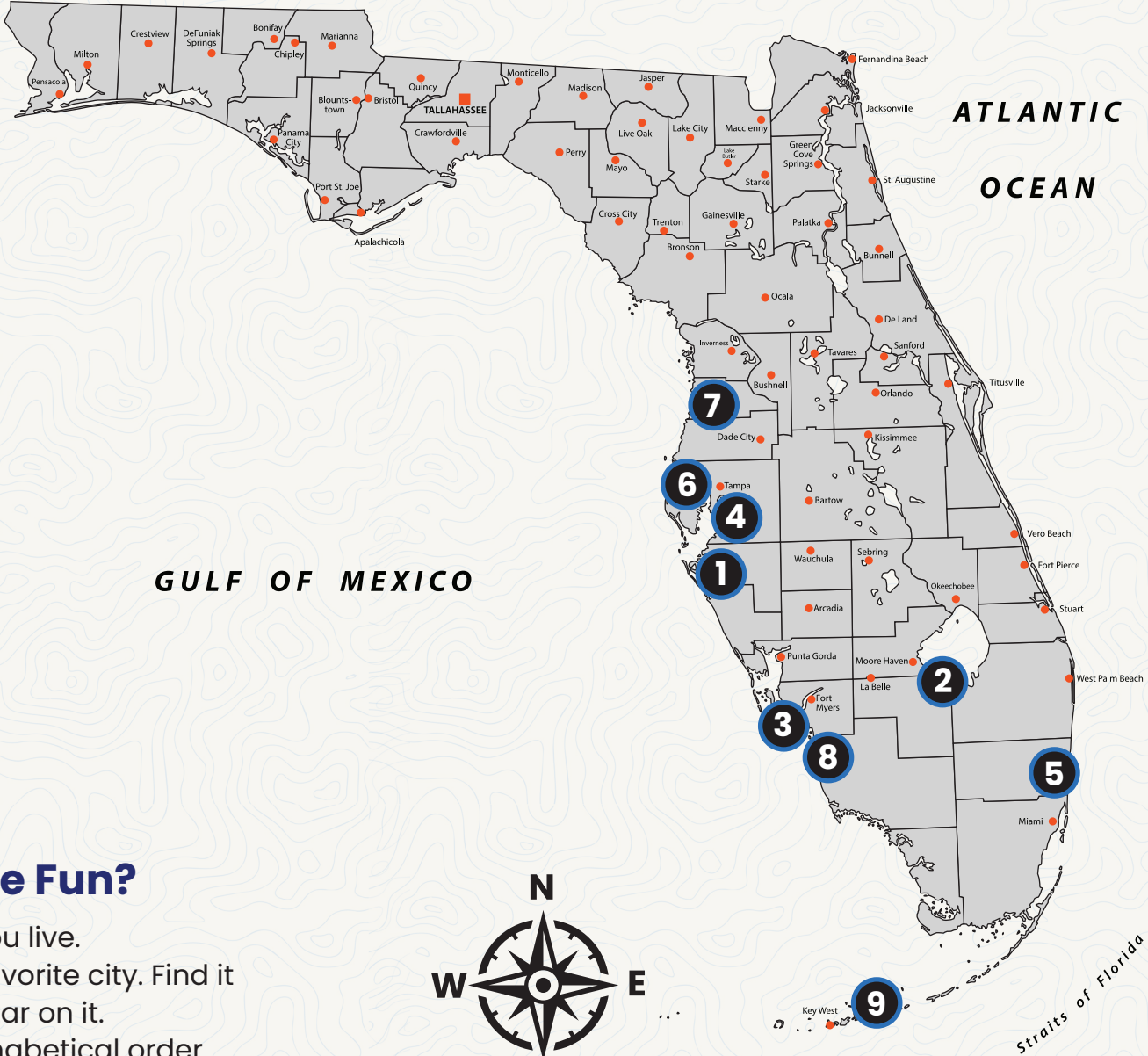

# October

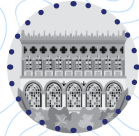
**Fun Place:** Myakka River State Park

Write, say, or show what you might see, smell, hear, touch, and imagine tasting on this adventure.






## Apollo Beach

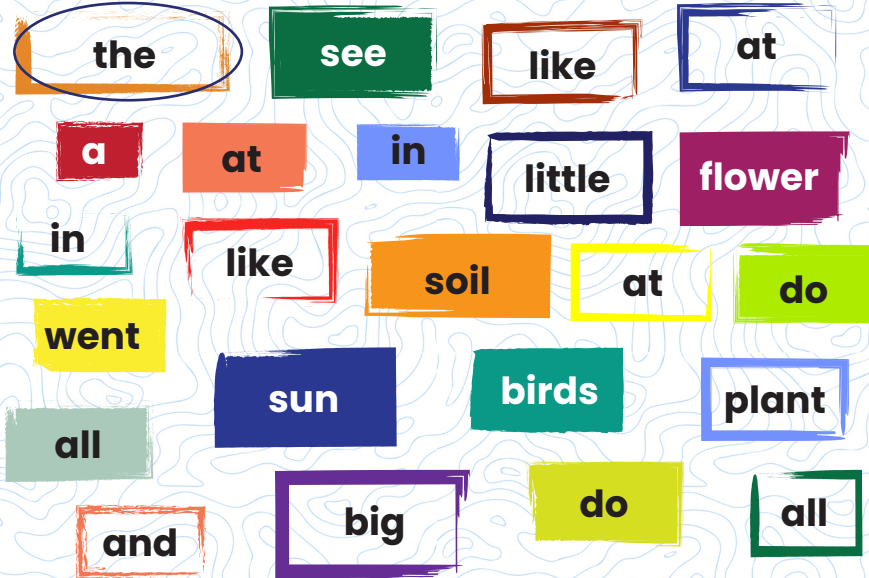
Watch mighty manatees gather in groups as these gentle giants hang out with their friends, enjoying Florida's warm winter waters.

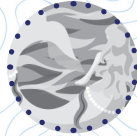

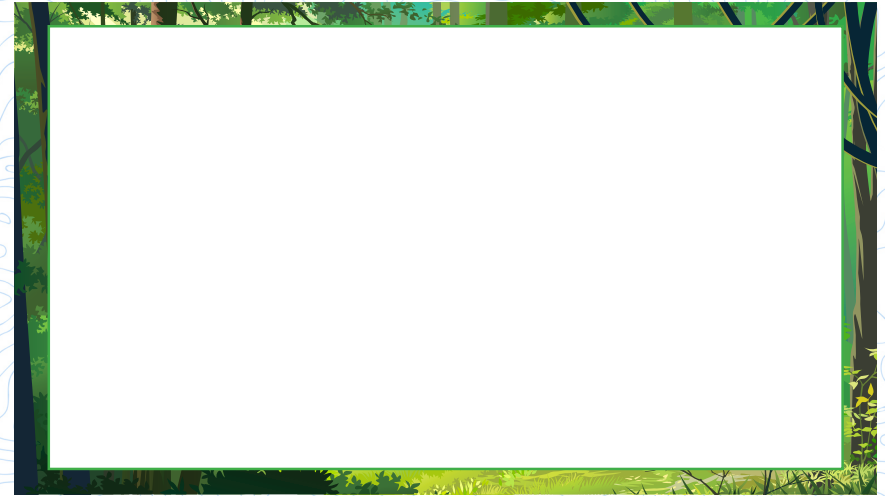

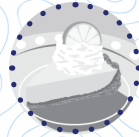
# June

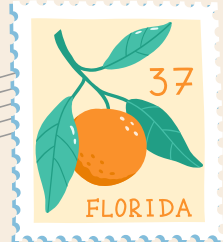
